Every warrior fears failure.

When a warrior's fear of failure exceeds his faith in God, he becomes hesitant.

How do you overcome the fear of failure?

1. Change the way you view failure.

Proverbs 24:16

Psalm 27:1

2. Surrender the outcome to God

Judges 6:13

- The warrior can't control the outcome, he can only control the effort.
- The victorious warrior wins the war one battle at a time.

3. Believe God will give you what it takes to succeed.

Judges 6:14

2 Peter 1:3
